Additional sites being onboarded for Prospect and Integra. Analysis framework/process being developed for site compliance into USCDI requirements.
Community Resource Platform (CRP)	State-led	Unite Us	Ends SFY 2024	 EHR Integration (Athena) with Prospect implementation in process and slated for go live by end of March. EHR Integration (NextGen) with BVCHC in process. Training of DCYF Support and Response Unit (SRU) staff on Unite Us platform completed. Sustainability options discussions in process. Over 440 organizations, with a total of 1,059 programs, are now part of the Unite RI network.
