Respite care for children is a program that allows parents or guardians caring for a child with disabilities to have time off for themselves. To be eligible for Respite, a child must need an institutional level of care that can best be described as the type of care typically provided in a hospital, nursing home or Intermediate Care Facility. Parents/guardians will be required to find their own Respite worker, but assistance will be available. To apply for Respite, families with children covered by RiteCare seeking respite services shall reach out to their health plan or a respite agency directly. Families with children covered by fee for service Medicaid seeking respite services will be directed to complete an application and submit to EOHHS/Kimberly Splendorio.
