Nursing Facility Training Grants



- The Nursing Facility Training Grant Program was established pursuant to RIGL § 23-17.5-36 and is designed to help nursing facilities provide enhanced training for employees, specifically; behavioral healthcare, dementia care, and/or training(s) that otherwise improve quality of care for patients with cognitive impairments.
- The program provides 100% cost reimbursement for eligible costs on eligible training activities up to \$30,000 per year.
- The program is available only to nursing facilities licensed by the RI Department of Health and subject to compliance with the minimum staffing requirements outlined in RIGL § 23-17.5-32
