Aspart of the FY23 Budget signed by Governor McKee, EOHHS is required to provideMedicaid coverage to all children that are residents of Rhode Island who wouldotherwise be eligible for Medicaid but for their immigration status (effectiveJuly 1, 2022). This regulation has been amended to reflect these changes.

The Agency does not expect this filing to be controversial and therefore, a public hearing will not be held.
