Quality measures for 2024 being evaluated. Strategic planning sessions with IMAT scheduled for November. |
| Community Resource Platform (CRP) | State-led | Unite Us | Ends SFY 2024 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> EHR Integration (Athena) with Prospect implementation project continues to progress. Discussions with DHS continue regarding the potential usage of the Unite Us platform. Refugee Assistance program is slated as the first DHS agency. DCYF will be moving forward with utilizing the Unite Us platform. State team is working to promote opportunities for CCBHCs. Over 424 organizations, with a total of 898 programs, are now part of the Unite RI network. |
| Health Information Exchange (HIE) | Statewide | RIQI | Approved through SFY 2024 | Butler Hospital facility-identified alerts for discharges are live; providers must be listed with a Direct address in NPPES and patient must consent to the notification in order to receive an alert. AE attribution report for admissions at Butler has also gone live. Exploring additional hospital units that may benefit from the report. |
| Demographic Data Standardization | State-led | N/A | CDC Grant Ends May 2024 | The Demographic Data Collection Pilot educational webinar series continues, with the most recent session covering Demographic Data Standards. At CTC-RI's recent annual conference, NCQA presented to health care organizations on the framework of the NCQA Health Equity Accreditation training program. |
| Behavioral Health Record-Sharing | Statewide | N/A | N/A | The Mental Health Care Coordination bill S719 was signed into law by Governor McKee. Further dissemination is being planned. |
