The **21st Century Cures Act** directs state Medicaid programs to require Personal Care and Home Health Services Providers to use an Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) system to document the services rendered.

Use of an EVV system to document Personal Care and Home Health Services will be mandated as of January 1, 2020. Providers are responsible for ensuring that they are in compliance with the federal requirements listed below.

Federal law requires that providers use the EVV system to document the following information:

- Type of service performed
- Individual receiving the service
- · Date of the service
- Location of service delivery
- Individual providing the service
- Time the service begins and ends

In preparation for the January 1, 2020 go live date, Rhode Island-EOHHS is requesting that providers please provide the following information to help identify providers who might require additional support in order to meet the January 1, 2020 deadline.
