## HealthSourceRI (HSRI) Insurance Coverage Resources – Brand Manager Christian Vialva and Chief Public Affairs Officer Robin Dionne

- [HealthSource RI](#) (HSRI) is the state’s official marketplace for health coverage.
- [American Rescue Plan](#) (ARP) allocated federal funds toward increased health coverage assistance for qualifying individuals, including most individuals with HSRI coverage.
- HSRI is currently offering a [New Enrollment Period](#) (NEP) from February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 to August 15, 2021 to provide eligible Rhode Islanders with additional time to enroll in 2021 health coverage. Additionally, [Special Enrollment Period](#) (SEP) is available for any individual experiencing a Qualifying Life Event (QLE).

## COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution and Data Update – Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) team
