- Equity Council members were asked for their feedback about the current structure and function of the Equity Council.
- The co-chairs of the Commission for Health Advocacy and Equity (CHAE) shared information about the commission, which focuses on promoting health equity across State agency and has legislative powers. Individuals from the community interested in being part of the CHAE can express their interest by filling out the <u>CHAE Expression of Interest form</u>.
- The Equity Council mission is to actively shape the State's COVID-19 response to
 effectively serve the populations most impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, including
 communities of color and high-density communities, in tangible ways. For more

Community Feedback: What are you hearing from the community? What should the State know?

- A member of the Council noted that vaccine hesitancy has now surpassed vaccine inaccessibility as one of the primary reasons why individuals are not getting vaccinated. In response, Council members emphasized the importance of focusing more resources toward educational materials and fighting misinformation.
