## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Rhode Island Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) is scheduling the public hearing noted below in response to a request from the *Community Health Worker Association of Rhode Island*.

The hearing is related to the following EOHHS proposed State Plan Amendment:

## **Community Health Worker Services**

EOHHS is seeking federal authority to add coverage of community health worker (CHW) services. Certified CHWs will provide health promotion and coaching; health education and training; health system navigation and resource coordination services; and care planning with a member's interdisciplinary care team. CHW services will be available to Medicaid eligible individuals who have one or more chronic health (including behavioral health) conditions, who are at risk for a chronic health condition, and/or who face barriers meeting their health or health-related social needs.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws, as amended, that the Secretary will hold a public hearing on the above mentioned matter on <u>Friday, August 13</u>, <u>2021 at 11:00 a.m</u>. at which time and place all persons interested therein will be heard.
