**8/29/22 PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO RHODE ISLAND MEDICAID
STATE PLAN**

In accordance Rhode Island General Laws 42-35, notice is hereby given that the Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) proposes to make the following amendment to the Rhode Island State Plan under Title XIX of the Social Security Act:

Parents as Teachers Program

EOHHS is seeking approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to update Rhode Island's Medicaid State Plan to provide Parents as Teachers services. The requested effective date for this SPA is October 1, 2022 and this change is expected to result in an increase in annual expenditures of approximately \$676,000 All Funds.

In accordance with the Rhode Island General Laws 42-35-2.8, an oral hearing will be granted on the proposed State Plan Amendment if requested by twenty-five (25) persons, an agency, or by an association having at least twenty-five (25) members. A request for an oral hearing must be made within ten (10) days of this notice.

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1905(a)(13) Preventive Services

13C.4 Family Home Visiting Program for Caregivers

1. A family home visiting program that aims to increase caregivers' knowledge of early childhood development, build parenting skills, and prevent child abuse and neglect. On the recommendation of a licensed practitioner of the healing arts, family home visiting program visitors deliver services to families in the home, including:
 - a. Developmental screening for children;
 - b. Psychoeducation on child development;
 - c. Parenting skill building;
 - d. Connecting families to resources.
2. These services are available to Medicaid beneficiaries who are caregivers
3. Children are primarily identified for referral through the developmental screening and risk assessment completed via a home visiting program, a health care provider or other service provider. .
4. Provider Qualifications
 - a. Agencies who provide the program must meet Certification standards for the family home visiting program.
 - i. Certification requirements include:
 1. Demonstration of commitment to linguistic and cultural competence by the entity.
 2. Plan to recruit, retain, and promote a diverse staff and leadership team.
 3. Entity assurance of equal access as outlined by the Department of Justice, Prohibition Against National Origin Discrimination affecting Limited English Proficient Persons.
 - ii. Individuals providing home visits include:
 - i. Home visitors (Associates degree in related field or Bachelors degree required)
 - ii. Supervisors (Masters degree required)

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1. Payment methodology

- a. Agencies bill the state Medicaid agency or RIDOH directly on a per-visit basis
- b. The rates are structured to capture the cost of direct services, including intake visits and care coordination, and indirect services, such as billing activities in accordance with 2CFR 200 and the RI approved cost allocation plan.

2. Rate Increases:

EOHHS does not increase rates based on a set inflation factor on a pre-determined basis

3. Date of Effective Rates

EOHHS' rates were set as of October 1, 2022 and are effective for services on or after that date.
