**Subject: MAPCO 2023 Information** 

EOHHS will be conducting it's Medicaid Annual Plan Change Opportunity (MAPCO) for members enrolled in managed care from July 1, 2023 through the end of Return to Normal Operations (April 30, 2024). Members may switch their plans no more than one (1) time every six (6) months from when they first make a plan change request. Members can make a plan change through two options: 1) Calling HSRI and requesting a plan change; or, 2) Making the change through the just cause form and selecting "Change My Health Plan."

Information and links to the Health Plan Change Request forms have been updated on the EOHHS website (Medicaid Annual Plan Change Opportunity page).

EOHHS requests that MCOs submit marketing materials through the Marketing review process as outlined in 2021 RI Medicaid MCO Marketing Guidelines. Marketing Guidelines are on the <u>RI EOHHS website</u>. MAPCO Open Enrollment marketing materials must be submitted for standard review, thirty (30) days prior to MCO's anticipated document release date and include 'Open Enrollment\_2023' in the subject line. **MAPCO Open Enrollment cannot be marked for expedited review.** 

MCOs that fail to receive approval on MAPCO Open Enrollment marketing materials from EOHHS will be in breach of the current Agreement and may receive a penalty and/or stopping enrollment to their MCO per 42 C.F.R. requirements.
