Summary of Rulemaking Action:

Effective 7/1/23, as part of the FY2024 Budgetas enacted, the RI legislature directed EOHHS to raise the state supplementalpayment for personal needs allowance for institutionalized individuals fromtwenty dollars (\$20.00) to forty-five dollars (\$45.00). This raises thetotal personal needs allowance for institutionalized individuals (state andfederal) from fifty dollars (\$50.00) to seventy-five dollars (\$75.00). EOHHS is also updating regulatorylanguage to replace dollar values with definitions and publishinginformation for the following: MonthlyFederal Benefit Rates (FBR), Optional State Supplement Payment (SSP)Limits, Student Earned Income Exclusion (SEIE), Minimum and MaximumMonthly Maintenance of Need Allowance, Community Spouse Monthly HousingAllowance, Minimum and Maximum Community Spouse Resources, andthe Minimum Home Equity Limit. Finally, EOHHSis providing updated amounts that better reflect current costs of receivingservices at private nursing facilities, intermediate care facilities, andlong-term care hospitals.
