Summary of Rulemaking Action:

Effective7/1/23, as part of the FY2024 Budget as enacted, the RI legislature directedEOHHS to raise the state supplemental payment personal needs allowance forinstitutionalized individuals from twenty dollars (\$20.00) to forty-fivedollars (\$45.00). This raises the total personal needs allowance forinstitutionalized individuals (state and federal) from fifty dollars (\$50.00)to seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).
