

# **Recent Updates**

Update	Rationale
Update #1 (Certification): RI will use certification standards and not an RFP to contract with case management entities.	<ol> <li>This new approach presents the greatest opportunity for RI to meet CFCM capacity requirements.</li> <li>RFI feedback</li> <li>Using this method gives the state the opportunity to increase compacity ongoing.</li> <li>Allows for greater opportunities for participant choice.</li> </ol>
Update #2 (Population): Case management entities may choose to support all populations (participants with I/DD and EAD) under CFCM or choose to serve one population only. The State's original design required case management entities to serve all populations.	<ol> <li>Allows for greater flexibility in RI's system to meet CFCM capacity.</li> <li>Addresses stakeholder and RFI vendor challenges in supporting all HCBS populations.</li> <li>Allows case managers to focus on specific population needs.</li> </ol>

- Oct 2023 Certification standards
- Nov 2023 CFCM training curriculum is developed
- Dec 2024 Full compliance
