

Civil Monetary Penalty Application Review – EOHHS Criteria

The following criteria are used to guide selections based on alignment with EOHHS’ mission and strategic goals.

1) Does the request exceed available funding?

CIRCLE ONE	Instructions

2) How well does the project align with EOHHS’ mission and strategic goals?

The project is evidence-based (either based on an existing program with proof of demonstrated success or the applicant provides a sufficiently detailed methodology for measuring outcomes that is reasonably related to the objectives of the project)		15%		
The project is data driven with quantifiable targets and goals and a process to measure and review success		15%		
The project can be completed within one year or less		10%		
The project is approved in another state		10%		

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The project is an innovative way to improve quality in nursing homes		5%		
The project is cost effective (cost per resident impacted)		5%		
The project is likely to produce results that could be used to benefit residents statewide		5%		
The project can be sustained after the grant period ends		5%
