**SUBJECT: Public Notice of Proposed Rulemaking**

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These regulations are being promulgated pursuant to the authority contained in R.I. Gen. Laws Chapter 40-8 (Medical Assistance); R.I. Gen. Laws Chapter 40-6 (“Public Assistance”); R.I. Gen. Laws Chapter 42-7.2; R.I. Gen. Laws Chapter 42-35; and Title XIX of the Social Security Act;

### **210-RICR-30-05-2 Medicaid Managed Care Delivery Options**

The Secretary of the Rhode Island Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) has under consideration an amendment to the Medicaid regulations entitled, 210-RICR-30-00-1 Medicaid Affordable Care Coverage Groups Overview and Eligibility Pathways.

EOHHS is revising regulation to remove the incorrect Parent/Caretaker income threshold. The agency incorrectly implemented a threshold of 136% FPL (141% with the 5% disregard) for which the agency does not have authority.

Additionally, EOHHS is removing language that describes the Medicaid Consumer Advisory Committee. The work of this group will transition to the Beneficiary Advisory Council (BAC) which the State will be implementing as it is a required provision of the Ensuring Access to Medicaid Services Final Rule (Access Final Rule).

Technical revisions are also included in this amendment.

In accordance with R.I. Gen. Laws 42-35-2.8(c), an opportunity for a hearing will be granted if a request is received by twenty-five (25) persons, or by a governmental agency, or by an association having not less than twenty-five (25) members, within ten (10) days of this notice that is posted in accordance with R.I. Gen. Laws 42-35-2.8(a). A hearing must be open to the public, recorded, and held at least five (5) days before the end of the public comment period.
