11/14/2025 PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE RHODE ISLAND MEDICAID STATE PLAN

Rhode Island assures compliance with 42 CFR 440.386 by providing the public with advance notice of the amendment and reasonable opportunity to comment, ensuring full access to EPSDT services, and adhering to the provisions of section 5006(e) of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

In accordance Rhode Island General Laws 42-35, notice is hereby given that the Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) proposes to make the following amendment to the Rhode Island State Plan under Title XIX of the Social Security Act:

Alternative Benefit Plan (ABP)

EOHHS is seeking approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to amend Rhode Island's Medicaid State Plan to update the State's Alternative Benefit Plan (ABP) to include services added to the Medicaid State Plan between 2014 and 2025 and to reflect the elimination of the Primary Care Case Management (PCCM) program. The proposed amendments to the Medicaid State Plan are strictly intended to align the State's ABP with all services currently covered by Rhode Island Medicaid, which have been expanded in the ten years since the ABP was first developed. This update does not effect benefits or change covered services, and there is no impact on Medicaid beneficiaries.
