| Quality Reporting System (QRS)       | State-led | IMAT Solutions | Ends SFY 2024                | An Electronic Data Exchange (ECDE) subgroup has been formed with participants from all QRS sites. Purpose of the subgroup is to discuss and develop standards for the exchange of QRS measures data between the participants and IMAT. Testing underway with LEAD and Development measure data from KIDSNET.  |
| Community Resource<br>Platform (CRP) | State-led | Unite Us       | Ends SFY 2024                | Discussions continue with DHS for a possible pilot of Unite Us with the Refugee Assistance program. EHR Integration with Prospect (Athena) implementation is scheduled start by the end of June 2023 with an eight-week implementation time-frame. There were 22 additional partners (403 Total) added to the Unite RI network YTD 2023. Over 3,110 electronic referrals have been processed in YTD 2023. This is an increase of 700+ referrals from the same period last year-2022.  |
| Health Information<br>Exchange (HIE) | Statewide | RIQI           | Approved through<br>SFY 2023 | Continuing to work with Butler Hospital to improve communication around psychiatric discharges.   |
| Demographic Data<br>Standardization  | State-led | AHP,<br>CTC    | CDC Grant Ends May<br>2024   | CTC-RI is finalizing the Best Practice Summary Report and the Current and Anticipated Standards/Requirements Summary Report.  EOHHS has outreached to several organizations in the state to request sharing aggregate-level demographic data to be included in the Baseline RI Demographic Data Collection Performance Assessment Report. McKenney is sponsoring the companion bill S719.
