Dear Medical Assistance Provider

Effective October 4, 2010, the RI Department of Human Services will implement a State Maximum Allowable Cost (SMAC) pricing methodology for multi-source products that have at least three manufacturers. The SMAC will be set at the median price for all NDCs listed in each drug/strength class. Pharmacy claims will now be reimbursed at the lower of WAC, FUL, Usual & Customary or State MAC plus the customary pharmacy dispense fee.

Pharmacy claims affected by the implementation of State MAC include: Fee-for-Service Medical Assistance claims, Department of Health (ADAP) claims, and Community Medication Assistance Program (CMAP) claims. The State MAC list is available on the DHS website for your review.
