Updates from the Last Meeting

- A Council member worked with the Providence Revolving Fund to create the <u>Providence</u>
 <u>Commercial Corridor Micro-Business Loan Program</u>, which will provide emergency funding to
 micro-businesses to help address safety measures needed for reopening due to the COVID-19
 pandemic.
- The State distributed 400,000 surgical masks to the ten <u>Health Equity Zones</u>, and another 4,000 were given to faith communities. Additionally, several Council members are working with <u>Project Undercover</u> to help meet the emergency supply needs of kids.
