# RI Department of Health COVID-19 Vaccination Subcommittee | Equity Council and COVID-19 Vaccine Subcommittee members Pastor Chris Abhulime, Pablo Rodriguez, MD and Larry Warner

- There are currently large-scale clinical distribution trials in progress or being planned for five COVID-19 vaccines. The distribution of a COVID-19 vaccine is projected to occur in the coming weeks and months.
- The State is working on developing a plan for a phased approach to vaccine distribution, with
  more vulnerable populations being given priority. This strategy is being developed using data in
  order to minimize COVID-19 morbidity and ensure equitable distribution. For more information,
