# COVID-19 Vaccination | RI Department of Health (RIDOH) Consultant Dr. Philip A. Chan

# COVID-19 Data Update | RIDOH COVID-19 Coordinated Response Lead at the Rhode Island Department of Health Julian Drix

- Age-adjusted COVID-19 data makes the disparity between white populations and Black/Latino populations more visible.
- Over \$138,000 in cash assistance has been distributed to over 173 households that have one or more COVID-positive individuals.
