## HealthSourceRI (HSRI) Insurance Coverage Resources – Brand Manager Christian Vialva and Chief Public Affairs Officer Robin Dionne

- <u>HealthSource RI</u> (HSRI) is the state's official marketplace for health coverage.
- <u>American Rescue Plan</u> (ARP) allocated federal funds toward increased health coverage assistance for qualifying individuals, including most individuals with HSRI coverage.
- HSRI is currently offering a <u>New Enrollment Period</u> (NEP) from February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 to August 15, 2021 to provide eligible Rhode Islanders with additional time to enroll in 2021 health coverage. Additionally, <u>Special Enrollment Period</u> (SEP) is available for any individual experiencing a Qualifying Life Event (QLE).

## COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution and Data Update – Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) team
